

Barcelona, San Sebastián, Bilbao, Logroño - 9 nights



Days 1-2 Barcelona (two-night stay)

Arrival & rental car at Barcelona airport El Prat.

Discovering the capital of Catalonia, two nights at hotel in Barcelona.

Sightseeing

Discover Barcelona with a general approach to its main tourist sights. A basic but complete itinerary will help you get to know the city by covering the most interesting places from the artistic and cultural point of view, such as the gothic cathedral, Plaça Catalunya, Passeig de Gràcia, Sagrada Família and not to forget the huge football arena Camp Nou.

Gastronomy

Among the best-known recipes of Barcelona there are stews, as la escudella i carn d'olla, made of vegetables, rice, noodles and potatoes, cocido con judias blancas, made of butifarra (a typical regional sausage), pilota (a preparation of beef), bread, eggs and white beans, faves a la catalana, botifarra amb monjetes and arroz a la cazuela, a dish similar to the famous "paella valenciana".

Days 3-4 San Sebastian (two-night stay) departure from Barcelona.

Driving distance from Barcelona to San Sebastian: 5 hours 20 minutes (575 km). Two nights at hotel in San Sebastian.

Sightseeing

San Sebastian stands in a glorious setting on a scallop-shaped bay framed by two hills (Monte Urgull and Monte Igueldo) and the small island of Santa Clara. The vast sand beaches follow the curve of the bay: La Concha beach and beyond the promontory, the fashionable Ondarreta beach. Behind are gardens, promenades and luxury apartment blocks and beyond, at the foot of Monte Igueldo, the Peine del Viento, a work by the Basque sculptor Eduardo Chillida.

Gastronomy

One of the specialties of San Sebastian are its famous pintxos; culinary bites ranging from the original slice of bread piled with food, to tiny miniature haute cuisine creations. Gastronomy is an art and feature that sets the city apart and that is what has earned the city widespread fame; the quality of San Sebastian's cuisine is well known all over the earth. Three of the seven 3-Michelin star restaurants in Spain are located in this city.

Day 5-6 Bilbao (two-night stay)

Departure from San Sebastian. Driving distance from San Sebastian to Bilbao: 1 hour 10 minutes (100 km). Two nights at hotel in Bilbao.

Sightseeing

Bilbao is the largest city in the Basque Country and maintains a beautiful historic quarter with a dominating gothic cathedral. One of the most famous attractions in Bilbao is the Guggenheim Museum.. The structure is considered to be one of the most important pieces of contemporary architecture.. The famous bridge Zubizuri is located next to the museum, designed by architect Santiago Calatrava.

Gastronomy

Just like San Sebastian, Bilbao's gastronomy is part of the Basque cuisine, but it has its quirks. There are products that are only sold in Bilbao and dishes that pay their particular culinary tribute to Bilbao. We speak of pisto a la bilbaina, a ratatouille made with onions, peppers, courgette, tomatoes, beaten eggs and ham, with all the ingredients cut into very small pieces.

Days 7-8 Logroño (two-night stay)

Departure from Bilbao.

Driving distance from Bilbao to Logroño: 1 hour 30 minutes (140 km). Two nights at hotel in Logroño.

Sightseeing

Logroño is a city rich in history and traditions which have been preserved since the middle ages. From the old walls which surrounded the city, the Revellín wall and the Carlos I gate are still standing. The historic centre has significant cultural sites, such as the Cathedral of Santa Maria de la Redonda. It has also fine examples of civil architecture, such as the Palaces of the Marquis of Legarde, los Chapiteles or the Museum of La Rioja.

Gastronomy

Asparagus, beans, peppers, artichokes and other vegetables and pulses are the basic ingredients of a long list of dishes such as vegetable stew, potatoes 'a la Riojana', lamb and kid. La Rioja is synonymous with great Spanish wines. For decades, wines from la Rioja, protected by their own designation of origin standards, have been an obligatory reference throughout Spain and beyond.

Day 9 Barcelona (one-night stay)

Departure from Logroño. Driving distance from Logroño to Barcelona: 4 hours 20 minutes (380 km). One night at hotel in Barcelona.

Day 10 Barcelona

Next day, drop off car at Barcelona airport El Prat.
