**Barcelona - Valencia - Málaga - Sevilla - Madrid - Porto - Lisbon - 14 nights**



### Day 1

English speaking assistance upon arrival at airport.

Private transfer from Barcelona airport to the hotel in Barcelona.

Half day Barcelona sightseeing based on private basis.

Enjoy Barcelona, discovering the most interesting places from the artistic and cultural point of view: the Gothic Cathedral, Plaça Catalunya, Passeig de Gràcia, Sagrada Família...

**Overnight at hotel in Barcelona.**

### Day 2

Breakfast at the hotel.

Half day Montserrat excursion on private basis.

Montserrat, an imposing rocky outcrop, is the holy mountain of Catalonia, which houses the revered image of the Black Virgin. **Overnight at hotel in Barcelona.**

### Day 3

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Private transfer from Barcelona to Valencia.

Half day Valencia sightseeing based on private basis.

Valencia is trade and culture, cinema, theatre, museums and business. It is the centre of international and avant-garde design and one of the most active cities in Europe regarding fairs and conferences.

Explore Valencia starting at Plaza del Ayuntamiento (town hall square), from where most of the city's important monuments are located within a walking distance. Discover central market, former silk exchange "La Lonja", Plaza de la Reina with the cathedral and the orcherteria, the Gothic Miguelete bell tower, Turia river bed gardens and City of Arts and Sciences. **Overnight at hotel in Valencia.**

### Day 4

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Private transfer from Valencia to Málaga.

Half day Málaga sightseeing based on private basis.

Málaga is located in the center of a bay surrounded by mountain ranges, at the western end of the Mediterranean Sea and about 100 miles east of the strait of Gibraltar. Some of the places you will see during this tour are: cathedral church of the incarnation, roman theatre, gibralfaro mountain.

**Overnight at hotel in Málaga.**

### Day 5

Breakfast at the hotel.

Full day Granada sightseeing based on private basis.

Granada is situated at the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains. It was once the capital of the Moorish Kingdom, a reign which lasted almost 800 years. This has left Granada with the most important Moorish legacy in Spain; the Alhambra. The monument is one of the most brilliant jewels of universal architecture.

**Overnight at hotel in Málaga.**

### Day 6

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Private transfer from Málaga to Sevilla. Rest at hotel and afternoon at leisure.

**Overnight at hotel in Sevilla.**

### Day 7

Breakfast at the hotel.

Half day Sevilla sightseeing based on private basis.

The tour starts at the Isla de la Cartuja which was chosen as the site for the expo'92. The Plaza de España and adjoining Maria Luisa Park are among the most pleasant and impressive public spaces in Spain. The tour continues in Santa Cruz Quarters with its narrow white alleys, flowered patios and wrought ironed balconies.

**Overnight at hotel in Sevilla.**

### Day 8

Breakfast at the hotel and check out.

Private transfer from Sevilla to Madrid. Half day Madrid sightseeing based on private basis.

This half-day visit offers a complete tour of the history and architecture of the city of Madrid: Puerta de Alcalá, Cibeles, Puerta del Sol, Plaza de la Villa, Plaza Mayor, Carrera de San Jerónimo, Calle Atocha, Reina Sofia Museum, Atocha main railway station, Ministry of Agriculture, Prado Museum, Banco de España, Paseo de la Castellana, Bernabeu football stadium.

**Overnight at hotel in Madrid.**

### Day 9

Breakfast at the hotel.

Half day excursion to Toledo based on private basis.

Toledo is one of the Spanish cities with the greatest heritage of monuments. Known as the "city of the three cultures", Toledo preserves behind its walls an artistic and cultural legacy in the form of churches, palaces, fortresses, mosques and synagogues.

**Overnight at hotel in Madrid.**

### Day 10

Breakfast at hotel and check out.

Private transfer from Madrid to Porto half day Porto sightseeing based on private basis. Porto is the second largest city in Portugal. The history of Porto dates back to the 4th century, to the roman occupation of the Iberian peninsula, although Celtic and Proto-Celtic ruins have been discovered in several areas. The charm and character of its old quarters filled with cafes and shopping centers is matched by the cathedral area, perfect for exploring. The civic center of the city in the central Baixa quarter with broad avenues lined with banks and outdoor cafes, not forgetting the two- tiered covered daily market.

**Overnight at hotel in Porto.**

### Day 11

Breakfast at the hotel.

Half day bodegas Ferreira based on private basis.

Built by a family of wine makers from the Douro, in 1751, Ferreira is the only Porto Wine company that has always remained Portuguese through all its history. Dona Antónia Adelaide Ferreira contributed significantly to the consolidation of the brand, through her work to benefit the Douro region and its people. Facing the adversities of the 19th century, she became a symbol of strength still recognized today.

Ferreira invites you to discover a brand with over 250 years of history, in a tour through the cellars where, since the 18th century, Porto Wine ages in hundreds of wood casks and vats. Guided tour through the cellars, including a visit to the “D. Antónia Belongings Room” and the Museum, ending with a tasting of two Porto Wines. **Overnight at hotel in Porto.**

### Day 12

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Private transfer from Porto to Lisbon. Rest at hotel and afternoon at leisure. **Overnight at hotel in Lisbon.**

### Day 13

Breakfast at the hotel.

Half day Lisbon sightseeing based on private basis.

Drive through one of the main avenues of the city, till Rossio square – heart of the city. The tour continues with a little walk in Alfama, the oldest and the most picturesque quarter of the city. You will also see the famous Belem Tower and the Monastery of Los Jerónimos. **Overnight at hotel in Lisbon.**

### Day 14

Breakfast at the hotel.

Full day excursion to Sintra & Cascais based on private basis.

Sintra is located 30 km from Lisbon. In 1995 the town of Sintra was classified as a world heritage site, with architectural monuments that stand out such as the Town Palace, the Pena Palace and the Moorish Castle. Cascais is a former fishing village situated in the southern region of Portugal, where visitors can enjoy its picturesque architecture. Return to Lisbon along the coast, passing by Estoril, admiring the beautiful coast and its beaches.

**Overnight at hotel in Lisbon.**

Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Private transfer from hotel to Lisbon airport.
