### Day 1: Santiago de Compostela

Arrival in Santiago de Compostela and private transfer to hotel.  
Day at leisure to discover the city. **Overnight at hotel.**

### Day 2: Santiago de Compostela -Viveiro

Meeting in Santiago de Compostela. Following the reception, enjoy a city tour in this historical town, destination of devotees for over a thousand years, and admire its countless artistic jewels such as the Cathedral. After lunch, the luxury coach will take you to Ferrol, where the Transcantábrico train is waiting for you. The crew will offer you a welcome drink while the train takes you to the historic town of Viveiro. Enjoy a tour of its beautiful old town, have dinner and spend the night on board.

### Day 3: Viveiro – Oviedo

Just as every day, we begin the journey with a delicious breakfast. The Transcantábrico train will take you to Ribadeo, a historical town located on the border between Galicia and Asturias. From there, we will travel along the Lugo coast by coach as far as Las Catedrales Beach, one of the most spectacular in the world. Panoramic tour of Ribadeo and lunch. The train will then take us into the Asturias region. Arrival and tour of Lluvia, known as the White Town of the Green Coast, returning thereafter to the train, and heading towards Oviedo. **Overnight stay in Oviedo.**

#### **Day 4: Oviedo - Llanes**

We will start the day by visiting Gijon, a city open to the Bay of Biscay and packed with cultural events. Lunch. We will then travel to Oviedo, the Principality of Asturias' capital. Tour, returning thereafter to the train. Dinner on board as we travel to Llanes, where we will spend the night.

#### **Day 5: Llanes**

Today we will visit the heart of the Principality of Asturias. We will go up the heart of the Principality of Asturias in our coach to visit the magnificent Picos de Europa National Park. After visiting Lake Enol, we will head towards the Covadonga Sanctuary, a sacred site full of tradition and legend. Next is Cangas de Onís. Lunch, journeying thereafter to Llanes, a wonderful fishing town in eastern Asturias. Tour and free time. **Dinner and overnight stay in Llanes.**

#### **Day 6: Llanes - Potes – Cabezón de la Sal**

During breakfast the train will cross the border to Cantabria. We will go up to Potes in our coach, going through the impressive gorge called Desfiladero de la Hermida. After touring this charming Cantabrian town, we can enjoy a thermal circuit in La Hermida Spa. After lunch, we will visit El Capricho, in Comillas, a marvellous, colourist 19th-century villa designed by Antonio Gaudí. **Dinner and overnight stay in Cabezón de la Sal.**

#### **Day 7: Cabezón de la Sal – Santander**

The day begins with a visit to the town of Santillana del Mar with its beautifully preserved medieval town. Next you will be taken on a tour of Altamira Neocave, the finest realistic example of Upper Palaeolithic cave art. After lunch, return to the train to continue the journey to Santander. City sightseeing tour of the elegant capital of Cantabria and free time. Those who wish may visit El Gran Casino after dinner (admission included). **Overnight in Santander.**

#### **Day 8: Santander – Bilbao - Carranza**

In the morning, El Transcantábrico will start its journey to the city of Bilbao that has managed to reinvent itself after the decline of its heavy industry. City tour including admission to the famous Guggenheim Museum, epitome of the new Bilbao. After lunch, enjoy free time before returning to the train. **Dinner and overnight in Carranza**

#### **Day 9: Carranza – San Sebastián**

While enjoying the last breakfast on board, you will return to Bilbao, where the coach will comfortably take you to San Sebastian. Visit this city of elegant beauty and home to major cultural events. Private transfer from train station to hotel. **Overnight at hotel in San Sebastian.**

## Day 10: San Sebastián

Breakfast at the hotel and check out.
